Springdales School Dubai was inspected by DSIB from 14 to 17 December 2015. The overall quality of education provided by the school was found to be good.' This statement from the KHDA report gave us what we had worked towards the entire year Grade 9.....As a 'Good' would confirm the way forward with Grade 9 being the senior most class for 2016-17. It was indeed a memorable moment .The feeling of jubilation and relief, both amongst the students and Faculty, was palpable. Expansion of the Secondary section to Grade 9 coincided with our shift to Phase II.

The well-lit classrooms and the well-equipped Labs, Sports and recreational facilities provide the apt environment and climate for learning ensuring that our Grade 9 students utilize their potential to the full and emerge as winners. Just a month into the New Year and students have adapted admirably to the new surroundings and new ways.

Moving forward the Grade 9 Academic year and Curriculum has been modified and enhanced keeping in mind the requirements of CBSE and the CCE pattern. The emphasis in Grade 9 is on conceptual clarification through experiential learning in the classroom with greater focus on learning rather than teaching to the test.
