THEME OF THE MONTH

It is wonderful to see our little ones settled and all set for learning. They are getting more and more confident and responsible with each passing day.

Children were engaged in sensory play where they explored how things feel, smell and taste. Messy play helped nurture an awareness and understanding of the world that surrounds them. We were delighted to see them dressed up in their favorite characters for the carnival.

We, in Pre-KG, have taken "Rhymes" as the theme for the month. Rhymes are important for language acquisition and help with speech development. They help children develop auditory skills such as discriminating between sounds and developing the ear for the music of words. The rhyme which the tiny tots learned this week is "Twinkle, Twinkle Little Stars", simple one to start with, yet everyone's favorite.

To create an enabling environment for our youngest learners, we decorated the class with stars to resemble a vibrant starry night. The activities were planned to help the children enhance their imagination and creative skills.

Young learners were excited to make the dough stars with cookie cutters. They solved the star shaped puzzles with lot of curiosity.it was nice to see them use pincer grip to pick up the stars from the play dough. They were overjoyed to jump up and catch the stars hanging from the roof which helped to develop their gross motor skills.

The little ones enthusiastically designed their own night sky using play dough, glitters and small stars stickers. They were involved in many more fun filled activities related to the theme. Overall, it was a glittering week of fun and learning with our "LITTLE STARS".

WHAT WE LEARNT DURING THE WEEK

The following were our focused activities-

PERSONAL, SOCIAL, EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT:

WHAT WE LEARNT DURING THE WEEK

LITERACY:

- Learners were introduced to the letter "S s" with the phonic sound, associated pictures, related objects and song.
- · Learners wrote the "c curve" and "back curve" in their notebooks.

MATHEMATICS:

- Sorting and labelling different faces and emotions according to their attributes was much enjoy by our active minds.
- Learners were introduced to numbers 1,2,3 and 4 and their corresponding values through different activities.

WHAT WE LEARNT DURING THE WEEK

LITERACY:

Learners were introduced to the sound 'm' and 'd' words-am, man, mat, map, Sam, dip, dim, din, dad, and sad. They learned the new sight words 'are' and 'at' and revised all the sight words learned in KG1.

MATHEMATICS:

Learners were introduced to the concept of 'Number before, between and after. They also learned place value of numbers 1-30.

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD:

Learners learned about the internal body organs heart and lungs, they participated in various activities to explore how our internal system works. They also performed various physical activities like acting like an animal to learn about 'Muscle and bones' and how they give structure to our body and help us to move.

EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGNS::

Learners used their own choice of materials to create a model of skeleton. They explained in their own words the procedure they followed and the resources they used to make a skeleton.

PERSONAL, SOCIAL, EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT:

Children discussed about the internal body organs and their importance. A range of activities were held related to Muscles and bones. They displayed their own knowledge and understanding about Muscles, bones and internal body organs heart and lungs.

COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE:

Learners celebrated 'World Book Day' with great enthusiasm. They read a story book with their friends and discussed about their favorite part of the story.

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT:

Learners learned to do "Back Roll" and experimented different ways of moving.
