THEME OF THE MONTH - All About Me

After an entire month of fun learning with rhyme time, our children were transported to a world of fantasy. They develop communication and language skills, fine and gross motor skills through use of actions and activities. Tiny Tots are all set to be introduced to a new theme "All About Me".

This theme is designed to help children have an understanding of the human body and of their identities as boys and girls.

The children learnt the names of different parts of the body like hands, elbows, nose, eyebrows, fingers, nails to name a few. As they were learning to identify body parts, our tiny tots were encouraged to use muscles and move same using activities from fun filled book "Head to toe" and rhymes "Head, shoulders, knees and toes" among others.

During the week all the learners participated in activities like solving boy and girl puzzles, moulding clay to make eyes, nose, mouth, ears and hair. They also loved dressing up dolls as boys and girls in the proper attire. Through solving body parts puzzle kids understood the proper position of different body parts. To take this activity to the next level all the super learners were taught to balance objects on different body parts to improve their gross motor skills.

To summarize, activities conducted this week were to help our little ones not only develop basic understanding of body parts but also improve their ability and confidence by developing their skills.

WHAT WE LEARNT DURING THE WEEK

The following were our focused activities

Children answered riddles like "I am thinking of a body part that you put your shoes and socks over." What is it? etc.

· Learners learnt the technique of balancing and walking with a bean bag on their heads.

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

WHAT WE LEARNT DURING THE WEEK

LITERACY:

Learners were introduced to the sound 'h' and 'b' words-hot, hop, hit, hat, hug, hut, bit, bed, bun, bug, bag and bus, bat, bet, big, bad, bin and bib. They learned the new sight words 'get' and 'four' and revised all the sight words learned so far.

MATHEMATICS:

Learners were introduced to the concept of Skip Counting of '2'. They also revised the concept of 'Data Handling'.

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD:

Under the topic 'Summer Seasons', Various activities pertaining to this season were conducted. Children also conducted an experiment to know why we should we wear light colour clothes during Summer. Children enjoyed learning about 'Summer in Dubai', they were enlighten to know in spite of extreme heat there are many places in Dubai to enjoy summer.

EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGNS::

Learners used their own choice of materials to create different types of flowers using paper or play dough to represent the blooming of flowers during 'Spring'.

PERSONAL, SOCIAL, EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT:

Children discussed about the Summer Season and changes take place during summer. They expressed their thoughts and shared with their partners what they can how they can enjoy summer in Dubai.

COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE:

During discussion about 'Summer' learners listened and responded to the ideas expressed by others.

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT:

Learners learned co-ordination skills by sliding, wall climbing and using commando rope.

- Revise sight words and blending words.


















