WHAT WE LEARNT DURING THE WEEK

LITERACY:

- Learners were introduced to the letter "T t" with the phonic sound, associated pictures, objects and song.
- · Learners wrote letter "a" in their notebooks.
- · Phonic recognition activities were done in the text book- "Letter Sounds".

MATHEMATICS:

- Recall of shapes- semi-circle, pentagon, triangle, square and rectangle was done through various hands on activities as well as a graphing activity.
- · Learners were introduced to number 6 and 7.

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD:

- Learners experienced several activities related to the sense of smell. They played several games like- guess the smell.
- Learners also learnt about the sense of taste and how different areas on our tongue helps us to experience different tastes like sweet, sour, bitter and salty.

EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGNS::

• Hands-on learning is so much fun. Learners used various recycled resources to make lots of "t" related objects like a train, train track and truck.

WHAT WE LEARNT DURING THE WEEK

LITERACY:

Learners were introduced to the sound 'e' words- pet, get, set, met, pet, net, pen, men, den, ten and peg etc. They learned the new sight words 'he' and 'no' and revised all the sight words learnt so far.

MATHEMATICS:

Introduction to 'Tally Marks' was a new yet exciting venture for our super learners. 1,2,3,4,shut the door it's 5- please ask your child what it means! They revised the concept of tens and ones.

Values are integral part of our curriculum. We designed some activities within the class under the topic 'My values'.
