Theme of the Month - Colors & Shapes

Understanding colors and shapes is a tool for learning many skills. Keeping in mind the importance of colours and shapes in our daily life, this week our little learners were introduced to the color yellow along with the shapes- triangle and square. The 'scavenger hunt' activity was super liked by the children where they enthusiastically moved all around the KG block hunting for different colour objects and different shapes. One of the activities planned for the development of fine motor skills was paper tearing and sticking where the students were engrossed in completing an apple with yellow paper. Along with this they also traced shapes on sand. Getting practice with sorting at an early age helps on the path of applying logical thinking to objects, mathematical concepts and everyday life in general hence activities like sorting picture and objects had our little ones totally engaged. Use of paints is an all time favourite with our Pre Kindergarteners and they showed their skills as they did fork painting and created their unique sunflowers. The smart board activities also exposed the little champs on being acquainted to using the latest technology while they learn. Overall, it was a fun and colourful week with our adorable children. Number 2 and letter 'Aa' along with it's phonic sound were also introduced using rhymes and hands on activities.

WHAT WE LEARNT DURING THE WEEK

The following were our focused activities-

PERSONAL, SOCIAL, EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT:

Learners participated in circle time where they spoke about different colours, shapes and their favourite ones too. The tiny tots enacted stories and interacted with each other which helped develop social skills.

COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE:

'How' 'Why' and 'What' questions were asked during story time sessions to develop critical thinking and communication skills. Group activities were planned during the week to encourage the little ones have a better understand amongst their peers.

EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGNS:

Learners were introduced to different art and craft activities to enhance their creativity. Paper tearing and sticking was done on an apple The enthusiasm on the face of our super stars was worth a watch as they were engrossed while using the kinetic sand and paints. They also traced different shapes learned using various resources.

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD:

The different colours and shapes which were introduced during the week were encouraged to be identified in real life objects present in the environment. The excited students has great pleasure to identify the shapes and colours on the bulletin boards and on the floor of our colourful corridors.

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT:

Outdoor play - The children explored the outdoor play area as they played games planned by the teacher along with their classmates thus developing their gross motor skills.

PE and swimming – Children were taught how to jog on a line and follow simple instructions. Jumping over the hurdles was enjoyed by the energetic Pre-Kindergarteners. Splashing in the pool along with learning how to kick their legs and make bubbles in water was taught to our swimming champions.

WHAT WE LEARNT DURING THE WEEK

LITERACY:

- Sight words red and one was introduced.

MATHEMATICS:

- · Recap of numbers 1-9 with their number value was done using a ten frame format.
- · Learners matched number and quantity correctly using animal counting resources.

- · Learners were introduced to Sea Animals.
- · Learners enjoyed the save the sea animal from an oil spill activity.

WHAT WE LEARNT DURING THE WEEK

LITERACY:

Learners were introduced to the sound 'l' and 'll' words- lap, lab, lad, lit, leg, let, log, lip, lick, lock, bell, tell, sell, bill, pill, hill, doll and ill. They learned the new sight words 'she' and 'out' and revised all the sight words learned so far.

MATHEMATICS:

Learners were introduced to the concept of 'Greater than and lesser than'. They practiced 'Greater than and lesser than' using various hands-on activities.

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD:

Under the topic 'Harmful and Helpful Minibeasts', Children learned about the minibeasts who helps us like silkworm or honeybee. They also learned about 'Flying and Not Flying Minibeasts'.

EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGNS::

Learners used their own choices of materials to create 'Honeycomb'. They also created minibeasts using natural materials like twig, leaves, dry leaves and stones etc.

PERSONAL, SOCIAL, EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT:

Children discussed about 'Harmful and Helpful Minibeasts'. They expressed their thoughts about what do we get from helpful minibeast and they shared ideas to be safe from harmful minibeasts to their peers.

COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE:

During discussion about minibeasts that can fly and cannot fly, learners listened and responded to the ideas expressed by others.

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT:

Learners learned to negotiate space successfully while playing. Racing and chasing games with other children, adjusting speed or changing direction to avoid obstacles were their most favourite activities.
