## Theme of the Month

Our little ones can recognize number 1 and are familiar with letter "S" and it's phonic sound. To begin with they have learnt the "circle" shape and can name real life circular objects from their surroundings. They can sort red and blue colour objects and had fun with different hands on activities.

Learners were engrossed and excited in the story character as they demonstrated their acting skills by retelling the story. They had fun with hands on art and craft activities from dressing up the bears to making their own bear masks. They used droppers along with red and blue colour water which helped develop their fine motor skills. Children enjoyed baking circle shaped cookies in the role play.

Our kindergarten corridors have come back to life after the long break with the giggles and laughter of our adorable little ones.

# The following were our focused activities-

#### PERSONAL, SOCIAL, EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT:

Circle time was an interactive session as different concepts were introduced through games, rhymes and enactment by the teachers.

#### **COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE:**

'How' 'Why' and 'What' questions were asked during story time sessions to develop critical thinking and communication skills. It was a delight to watch our little stars dramatize the story character as they enthusiastically interacted with their peers at the role play area.

#### **EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGNS:**

Learners were introduced to different art and craft activities to enhance their creativity. They were engrossed in paper tearing and sticking activity on a sun. The tiny creative hands made wonderful snakes, snowman and sun using playdough. Learners got great hands on experience by colouring rice with red and blue food colours. They traced number 1 and letter S on the coloured rice

#### **UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD:**

Different emotions from the stories were used to develop critical thinking amongst the learners as they expressed different feelings in the given situations of the stories. Learners were also made aware of showing different feelings, and how to react

#### PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT:

**Outdoor play** - The children explored the colourful play are as they ran around and played long with their classmates thus developing their gross motor skills.

**PE and swimming** - Crawling under the hurdles and kicking the ball were super successful activities which helped develop coordination and listening skills. Learners learnt the technique of jumping over two hurdles.








































































