Theme of the Month - Colors & Shapes

Our little bundles of joy had a wonderful learning week filled with excitement. It is a great achievement to see our little ones with double enthusiasm in every coming week during the entire time spent at school.

In the continuation of the theme this week, we made our Pre kindergarteners familiar to the topics which include the letter 'T t' along with its phonic sound, the colour Green, number 3 alone with its number value and the rectangle shape as learning about shapes not only helps children identify and organize visual information, it helps them learn skills in reading, math, and science.

Different activities were planned which working on their fine motor skill development. Crumbling and pasting technique using paper was done to make different crafts which gave the super excited learners a hands on experience to create the rectangle shape,number3 etc. The colour green was seen all around the classes of Pre Kg as the little artists had an exposure to the colour through painting activities where they used Q tips, paint brush and other techniques to create bunches of grapes, tress etc. They enjoyed making tiger crafts associating with the letter T and the unique trains created by them using different color rectangular shapes was worth a watch. Learners enjoyed lacing different objects related to the topics which also helped improve their hand- eye coordination. The children went on nature walks to see and collect the different green leaves. They were made aware of the importance of eating green vegetables and growing plants. Our super stars were also involved in small group activities so as to improve upon their social and emotional bonding with their peers.

Overall it was a great week with lots of fun activities which took the knowledge and understanding of each topic to the next level.

WHAT WE LEARNT DURING THE WEEK

LITERACY:

Learners were introduced to the sound 'ss' words- fuss, loss, mess, kiss, hiss, boss and pass. They also learned 'Opposite words': come- go, in-out etc. They learned the new sight words 'yes' and 'but' and revised all the sight words learned so far.

MATHEMATICS:

Learners were introduced to the concept of 'Non Standard Measurement'. They practiced 'Non Standard Measurement' using various hands-on activities.

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD:

Under the topic 'Lifecycle of a butterfly' children learned about the different stages of lifecycle of a butterfly.

To prepare our learners for the upcoming topic 'Plants' children were engaged in a handson activity of sowing the seeds that they brought.

EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGNS::

Learners used their own choices of materials to create different stages of 'Life cycle of a butterfly.

PERSONAL, SOCIAL, EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT:

Learners performed various activities during 'Arabic week'. They learned about Arabic tradition, Arabic food, songs and dance.

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








































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
