THEME OF THE MONTH - Sea Animals

Welcome to another exciting week of learning! This week our tiny tots dived and explored into the ocean of learning where they came across different sea animals like Whale, Dolphin, Shark, Jellyfish and Crab.

The children were involved in different group discussions and they shared their views and opinions on their knowledge of sea life and their experiences. They were encouraged to get involved in 'What and How' questions. They interacted about what kind of fishes they have seen and where – e.g. Dubai Aquarium

Children shared their exciting experiences when they visited School Aquarium and were able to answer simple questions related to it.

Along with reinforcement of all the letters done until now, this week we introduced letter 'Cc' along with its phonic sound. The learners were encouraged to name few words starting with letter 'C'. Number value from 6 to 9 was done this week using several hands on activities and manipulatives.

Various indoor activities in the club helped in the enhancement of their coordination and motor skills. Our super learners enthusiastically explored different kids play area. WHAT WE LEARNT DURING THE WEEK

The following were our focused activities-

PERSONAL, SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT:

Children were involved in interactive activities about different sea animals. They expressed their views on what they eat and about their size. They also discovered that sharks and dolphins are the most intelligent sea animals.

COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

New vocabulary words such as Intelligent, smart, dive were introduced to them along with introduction to the letter 'C' and corresponding phonic sound as well as objects.

EXPRESSIVE ART AND DESIGN

Learners where engaged in different hands-on activities like creating aquarium using small fishes and different sea creatures. They created sea weeds by using the tearing and pasting technique. Various resources were used to create crafts on Shark, Dolphin, Jellyfish and Whale.

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD:

Learners were made aware of the importance of life under the sea and how it differs from life on land.

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT:

Outdoor play, Organized game, Stretching and Yoga. PE and Swimming

LIFE SKILLS:

Fine motor skill is the coordination of small muscles in movements usually involving the synchronization of hands and fingers with the eyes.


The learners performed the following life skills activities this week-

Learning table manners.









































































WHAT WE LEARNED DURING THE WEEK:

LITERACY:

Phonic recognition activities, blends and letter sequencing from n to z was done. Sight word help and jump was introduced.

MATHEMATICS:

Recap of numbers 1-19 was done. Learners wrote the numbers in a tens and one sequence format. Learners were introduced to number 20.

The concept of tens and ones was reinforced with lots of hands on activities and worksheets.

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD:

Learners learnt about the different types of Air and Water transport.

Learners discussed the difference between a Dhow and an Abra- related to water transport.

EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGNS:

Learners enjoyed making different types of air transport using popsicle sticks and recycled resources

PERSONAL, SOCIAL, EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT:

Learners were observed for following instructions and participating in rehearsals for Making Melodies. They displayed independence and responsibility.

COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE:

Learners participated in an interactive quiz on landmarks found in UAE. They shared their experience about their visit to these places.

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT:

Learners took part in climbing and balancing activities in the activity room.

WHAT WE LEARNT DURING THE WEEK

LITERACY:

Learners were introduced to the 'z' and 'zz' words- zero, zip, zap, zigzag buzz, fizz, jazz, puzzle, sizzle, fuzz and pizza. They learned the new sight words 'good' and 'soon' and revised all the sight words learned so far

MATHEMATICS

Learners were introduced to the new number names sixteen, seventeen, eighteen, nineteen and twenty. They also learned solving subtraction word problem using their reading skill and critical thinking skill.

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

Under the topic 'The Earth' Children learned about the planet by exploring the globe. They also learned about what causes day and night by conducting an experiment using a globe model and a torch.

EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN:

Learners used their own choices of materials to create their own 'Planet Earth'. They also learned new songs during practice session as they are gearing up for 'Making Melodies'.

PERSONAL, SOCIAL, EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT:

During our field trip to Butterfly Garden, children observed different kind of butterflies and expressed their ideas based on their own knowledge of minibeasts. They enjoyed exploring butterflies ,learning many facts and sharing their views with their peer.

COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

Children had some role play fun and enacted like Sun and planet Earth to explain what causes day and night.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION:

Children discussed about healthy food and it's benefits.

Arabic:

Learners revised all the Arabic letters and song/s learned so far.








































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
