This week the learners revised the previously learnt letters, their sounds and the pictures related to it. Our learners also revised numbers and number values through various hands on activities.

Various fun based games like I spy, follow the leader, who makes that sound? , pass the number cards etc. not only entertained the children but gave them an opportunity to think, guess and answer, thus tapping their thinking ability and communication skills.

Activities like connecting the links, play dough activity helped the learners develop their fine and gross motor skills.

- PE and swimming Crawling under the hurdles and kicking the ball were super successful activities which helped develop coordination and listening skills.

LIFE SKILLS:

- Fine motor skill is the coordination of small muscles in movements usually involving the synchronization of hands and fingers with the eyes.
- The learners performed the following life skills activities as a recapitulation: •

- They were also encouraged to use thread and unthread the beads.
- Using child friendly scissor.
- Learning table manner.

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








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
