WHAT WE LEARNT DURING THE WEEK

The following were our focused activities-

PERSONAL, SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT:

COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE:

Learners participated in an interactive session about the concept ‘In and Out’ where they used objects /props to discuss and explain about the newly learnt concept.

EXPRESSIVE ART AND DESIGN

Learners used various resources to develop their fine motor skills to design beautiful greeting cards using their own imaginations. They also made J for jacket/jelly bean jars and L for ladybug craft

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD:

Learners learnt about different school helpers (Bus attendant and Bus drivers) and their work places. Personal visit to meet and greet the support staff helped to have a better understanding of the topics.

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT:

Outdoor play – Developing gross motor skills in the outdoor play area has helped out little kindergarteners to be more helpful, caring and develop skills of sharing as they enjoy free play time.

PE- Learners participated in the sports day event, they also practiced different games which helped the little champs understand the value of cooperation and team spirit.

LIFE SKILLS

WHAT WE LEARNT DURING THE WEEK

The following were our focused activities-

LITERACY

- Phonic recognition activities and letter dictation from “n to z”
- (lower case) was done in the notebooks.
- Learners were introduced to ‘zz’ sound words like buzz, drizzle, sizzler ,dizzy ,pizza, puzzle, fizz.

MATHEMATICS:

- Recap of numbers 1-29 was done.
- Introduction of number 30 in Tens and ones format was done.
- Introduction of Capacity was done. Learners learned to compare the capacity of different containers using different manipulative.
- Learners wrote numbers 1-30 in their notebooks.

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD:

- Learners learnt to identify different types of uniforms/clothes.

EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGNS:

- Learners used toothbrush spray painting to create a new uniform print for workers.

PERSONAL, SOCIAL, EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT:

- Learners waited patiently and took turns in the Sports day event. They also displayed respect and unity as they cheered each other during the Sports Day.

COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE:

- Learners talked about their favorite community helper and made and wore paper hats related to them.

WHAT WE LEARNT DURING THE WEEK

The following were our focused activities-

LITERACY

Learners were introduced to 'Naming Words' They learned that a 'Naming Word can be the name of a person, place, animal or thing. They learned the new sight words 'black' and 'brown' and revised all the sight words learned so far.

MATHEMATICS:

Learners were introduced to 3D Shapes Sphere, Cube, Cylinder and Cone. They learned the properties of 3D Shape. Children were involved in hands on activities like rolling, sliding and stacking activities to know about their features of Roll, slide and stack. They also went for a walk outdoors to find 3D Shapes and observe how they are used in real life.

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD:

Under the topic ' Polar Habitat' Children learned about various Polar animals and Polar habitat features. They did a "Blubber" experiment to understand how animals in Polar habitat survive in extreme cold climate. In STREAM children made 'Polar animals' using recycle material.

EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGNS:

Learners used their own choice of materials to create Polar Habitat using recycle material.

PERSONAL, SOCIAL, EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT:

Children discussed about the 'Polar Habitat' they expressed their thoughts and shared their knowledge about Polar Habitat.

COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE:

Learners listened and interacted effectively during circle time and discussed about 3D shapes and their attributes.

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT:

Children enthusiastically participated in various physical activities on Sports Day. They were full of winning spirit and performing to the best of their ability.

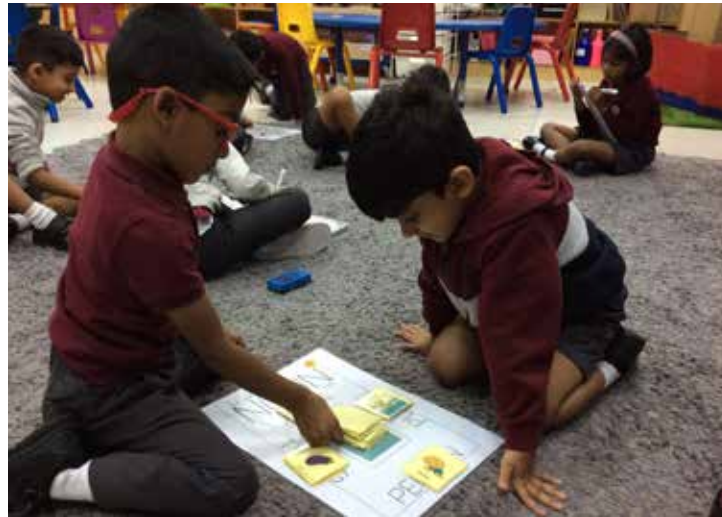
ARABIC
