· Learning table manner. Parents are requested to reinforce these skills at home PE- Along with some warm up exercise and running race, our learners practiced kicking the ball.

































































































































































PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT:


Learners took part in climbing the rock wall, balancing on the balance beams and climbing on a horizontal ladder in the activity room.



WHAT WE LEARNT DURING THE WEEK

LITERACY:

Children learned different ways of moving while practicing 'Graduation Day' dance.
































































































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
